Important reminder: If you changed your WiFi name (SSID) and/or password/pin at router.optimum.net, you will have to reconnect all of your wireless devices to your home network using the updated WiFi name (SSID) and password/pin.

A few tips to keep in mind

Having trouble connecting? Try these steps:

- **1** Make sure all your cord connections are tightly secured.
- 2 Make sure your Smart Router is standing upright.
- **3** Reboot instructions for modem and Smart Router:
- Unplug the power from your modem. If you are using a battery backup, you'll also need to disconnect it from the modem.
- Unplug the power from your Smart Router.
- Plug the modem back in and wait until it has fully restarted. This can take up to a few minutes. If you are using a battery backup, reconnect it to the modem.
- Plug the Smart Router back in and wait 30 seconds. Now check your internet connection by opening a web browser.
